



MEETING NOTICE AND AGENDA CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION



4. Discuss and consider potential Charter amendments, including, but not limited to the following:
 - (a) Vote required for the appointment or removal of the city manager, city attorney, and the city secretary;
 - (b) Term limits; and
 - (c) Signatory authority on deposit accounts.
5. Consider approving recommendations, if any, for the Charter Review Commission's final report.
6. Adjourn.
