

ORDINANCE NO. O-04-35

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSOURI CITY, TEXAS, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF MISSOURI CITY PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE DESIGN MANUAL; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSOURI CITY, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves and adopts the Public Infrastructure Design Manual attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, a copy of same being on file with the City Secretary.


Section 2. Penalty. Any person who causes, allows or permits another to violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). Each day such violation shall be permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.


Section 4. In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Missouri City, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.
