POLITICAL SIGNS ON PROPERTY IN THE
CITY OF MISSOURI CITY
Effective March 3, 2010

In addition to the rules and regulations set forth in the laws of the State of Texas and of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Missouri City, the City of Missouri City has established a policy concerning political signage on City-owned property as follows:

During early voting and through election day for an election in which the City Hall campus is being used as a polling location during early voting and/or on election day, there may be one unlighted political sign no larger than thirty-six square feet in area nor higher than five feet above natural grade, with no moving parts, erected on the island in front of City Hall, (east of the parking lot on Texas Parkway – not on the flag pole island), for each candidate, or in support for or against each proposition on the ballot. Political signs shall not be placed on any other location on the City Hall/Community Center/Library complex.

At all other times and on all other City-owned property not being used as a polling location for early voting and/or election day, the posting of political signs is prohibited.

Placement of signs violating the above rules will be removed by Missouri City staff and held until after the election or picked up by candidate, whichever is sooner.
