



New Plantings & Features

19 new trees were planted at Hunters Glen Park, near the basketball courts and south trail. This planting featured several fruit and nut trees, wetland trees, shade trees, and ornamentals. Two new memorial trees were planted at MacNaughton Park in honor of Kevin Hauber. Two new memorial trees were planted at Ridgeview Park in honor of Pat Hardman. 45 new trees were planted at the Tree Farm as replacements for trees that were transplanted into various parks this last season. The Tree Farm irrigation system was also renovated to accommodate the new trees.



Tree Pruning & Landscape Maintenance

Two large dead trees were removed at MacNaughton Park and Buffalo Run Park. Routine pruning and fertilization was conducted along some sections of the Edible Arbor Trail. Fire ant and weed control was conducted around mulched areas at 6 parks.

The Forestry Division crew gave a helping hand to the City of Sugar Land, on March 14th, at the Brazos River Park. The Sugar Land Parks Department and CenterPoint Energy conducted a Right Tree Right Place planting at this location, which was modeled after the successful project at Ridgeview Park. Missouri City staff helped coach community volunteers during the tree planting.
