ORDINANCE NO. O-21-__

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MISSOURI CITY, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2021, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MISSOURI CITY, TEXAS, CERTAIN PROPOSITIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR JOINT ELECTIONS ON NOVEMBER 2, 2021, WITH OTHER ENTITIES CONTRACTING WITH FORT BEND COUNTY AND HARRIS COUNTY, RESPECTIVELY, FOR SUCH JOINT ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR ELECTION PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Missouri City, Texas (the "City") has determined that a special election should be held in the City for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters certain propositions for the issuance of City bonds payable from ad valorem taxes for the purposes hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to proceed with the ordering of such election, and has determined that holding such election is in the public interest; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSOURI CITY, TEXAS:

Section 1. *Election order.* A special bond election is hereby called and ordered for the 2nd day of November, 2021 ("Election Day"), at which election all qualified voters residing within the corporate limits of the City of Missouri City, Texas, may vote for the purpose of considering the propositions set forth on Exhibit A hereto for the issuance of bonds for permanent public improvements for the City, the levy of taxes for payment thereof and the provision of a sinking fund to redeem the bonds at maturity shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the City. Said election shall be held in accordance with the Texas Election Code.

Section 2. *Election administrators.*

A. FORT BEND COUNTY. For the precincts of the City within Fort Bend County, for the special election called and ordered for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters several propositions for the issuance of bonds for permanent public

improvements for the City, the levy of taxes for payment thereof, and the provision of a sinking fund to redeem the bonds at maturity, the Fort Bend County Elections Administrator shall act as Contracting Officer. The election officials for each City of Missouri City precinct in Fort Bend County shall be designated by the Elections Administrator of Fort Bend County; and such election officials shall conduct the City's special election in accordance with the "Fort Bend County Joint Election Agreement and Contract" to be approved and entered into. The Elections Administrator of Fort Bend County is hereby authorized and instructed to provide and furnish all necessary election supplies for all City of Missouri City precincts in Fort Bend County. The Fort Bend County Early Voting Clerk may be contacted as follows:

B. HARRIS COUNTY. For the precincts of the City within Harris County, for the special election called and ordered for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters several propositions for the issuance of bonds for permanent public improvements for the City, the levy of taxes for payment thereof, and the provision of a sinking fund to redeem the bonds at maturity, the Harris County Elections Administrator shall act as Contracting Officer. The election officials for each City of Missouri City precinct in Harris County shall be designated by the Elections Administrator of Harris County; and such election officials shall conduct the City's special election in accordance with the "Harris County Joint Election Agreement and Contract" to be approved and entered into. The Elections Administrator of Harris County is hereby authorized and instructed to provide and furnish all necessary election supplies for all City of Missouri City precincts in Harris County. The Harris County Early Voting Clerk may be contacted as follows:

Section 3. *Election Day polling places.* The polling places for voting on Election Day for each City election precinct located in Fort Bend County shall be at the

locations designated by Fort Bend County as countywide polling places and as set forth in Exhibit B, attached hereto and made a part hereof. Exhibit B may be modified to include additional or different locations designated by the Fort Bend County Elections Administrator and to conform to the Fort Bend County Joint Election Agreement and Contract. The polling places for voting on Election Day for each City election precinct located in Harris County shall be at the locations designated by Harris County as the countywide polling places set forth in Exhibit C, attached hereto and made a part hereof. Exhibit C may be modified to include additional or different locations designated by the Harris County Elections Administrator and to conform to the Harris County Joint Election Agreement and Contract.

Section 4. *Election Day schedule.* Each polling place on Election Day shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 5. *Early voting polling places and schedule.* Early voting by personal appearance for each City election precinct located in Fort Bend County shall be at the locations, dates, and times as set forth in Exhibit D, attached hereto and made a part hereof. The location for the main early voting polling place for Fort Bend County precincts is designated as Fort Bend County Rosenberg Annex, 4520 Reading Road, Rosenberg, Texas. Exhibit D may be modified to include additional or different early voting locations, dates, and times designated by the Fort Bend County Elections Administrator and to conform to the Fort Bend County Joint Election Agreement and Contract. Early voting by personal appearance for each City election precinct located in Harris County shall be at the locations, dates, and times as set forth in Exhibit E, attached hereto and made a part hereof. The location for the main early voting polling place for Harris County precincts is designated as Harris County Law Library, Basement Conference Room, 1019 Congress Street, Houston, TX 77002. Exhibit E may be modified to include additional or different early voting locations, dates, and times designated by the Harris County Elections Administrator and to conform to the Harris County Joint Election Agreement and Contract.

Section 6. *Method of voting.* Voting at the election, including early voting by personal appearance, shall be by use of the voting system designated by the contracting entity and approved by the Texas Secretary of State. Early voting by mail shall be by paper ballot processed by an Early Voting Ballot Board through a voting system designated by the contracting entity and approved by the Texas Secretary of State.

Section 7. *Early voting clerk-Fort Bend County.* Fort Bend County Elections Administrator is hereby designated as the Early Voting Clerk for each City election precinct located in Fort Bend County. An application for a voting ballot to be voted by mail for each City election precinct located in Fort Bend County shall be mailed to the address listed in Subsection 2.A.i; submitted by common or contract carrier to the address listed in Subsection 2.A.ii; faxed to (281) 341-4418; or emailed as an attachment to the email address listed in Subsection 2.A.iv. Generally, an application

for a voting ballot to be voted by mail, must be received not later than the close of regular business in the early voting clerk's office or 12 noon, whichever is later, on the 11th day before election day unless that day is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state or national holiday, in which case the last day is the first preceding regular business day. For an application for ballot by mail submitted by telephonic facsimile machine or electronic transmission to be effective, the application also must be submitted by mail and be received by the early voting clerk not later than the fourth (4th) business day after the transmission by telephonic facsimile machine or electronic transmission is received.

Section 8. *Early voting clerk-Harris County.* The Harris County Elections Administrator is hereby designated as the Early Voting Clerk for each City election precinct located in Harris County. An application for a voting ballot to be voted by mail for each City election precinct located in Harris County shall be mailed to the address listed in Subsection 2.B.i; submitted by common or contract carrier to the address listed in Subsection 2.B.ii; faxed to (713) 755-4983 or (713) 437-8683; or emailed as an attachment to the email address listed in Subsection 2.B.iv. Generally, an application for a voting ballot to be voted by mail, must be received not later than the close of regular business in the early voting clerk's office or 12 noon, whichever is later, on the 11th day before election day unless that day is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state or national holiday, in which case the last day is the first preceding regular business day. For an application for ballot by mail submitted by telephonic facsimile machine or electronic transmission to be effective, the application also must be submitted by mail and be received by the early voting clerk not later than the fourth (4th) business day after the transmission by telephonic facsimile machine or electronic transmission is received.

Section 9. *Notice of changes.* The City Secretary shall provide notice of the election in accordance with state law and shall provide notice of any modifications to Exhibits B, C, D, and E on the City's internet website.

Section 10. *Ballot Language.* The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to prepare the ballot language in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code. Such ballot language shall correspond to each of the propositions set forth on Exhibit A to this Ordinance. The specific ballot language for each proposition shall be as described on Exhibit F hereto (the number of each proposition corresponding to the number of each proposition listed on Exhibit A to this Ordinance) with a provision allowing voters to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" each proposition.

Section 13. *Open meeting.* It is further found and determined that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of this meeting of the City Council was posted at a place convenient to the public at the City Hall of the City for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Ordinance and the subject matter thereof

has been discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The City Council further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.

Section 14. *Repeal.* Any ordinance or any part of an ordinance in conflict herewith shall be and is hereby repealed only to the extent of such conflict.

Section 15. *Severability.* That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance, or the application of same to a particular set of persons or circumstances, should for any reason be held to be invalid or adjudged unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance, and to such end the various portions and provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable; and the City Council of the City of Missouri City, Texas, declares it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.

Shall the City Council of the City of Missouri City be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the amount of \$51,615,000 maturing serially or otherwise at such times as may be fixed by the City Council not to exceed 40 years from their date or dates and bearing interest at any rate or rates, either fixed, variable or floating, according to any clearly stated formula, calculation or method not exceeding the maximum interest now or hereafter authorized by law as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council at the time of issuance, and to levy a tax upon all taxable property in the City sufficient to pay the interest on the bonds, and to provide a sinking fund for the payment of bonds as they mature, for the purpose of making permanent public improvements as follows: (1) purchasing, acquiring, enlarging, extending, equipping, and constructing street, bridge, and sidewalk improvements and facilities within the City, including acquiring land and rights-of-way for such purposes, (2) purchasing equipment and support facilities in connection with street, bridge and sidewalk improvements, (3) preparing engineering and related studies in connection with street, bridge and sidewalk improvements in the City and (4) all matters necessary or incidental thereto?

CITY OF MISSOURI CITY, TEXAS, PROPOSITION B

Shall the City Council of the City of Missouri City be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the amount of \$11,220,000 maturing serially or otherwise at such times as may be fixed by the City Council not to exceed 40 years from their date or dates and bearing interest at any rate or rates, either fixed, variable or floating, according to any clearly stated formula, calculation or method not exceeding the maximum interest now or hereafter authorized by law as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council at the time of issuance, and to levy a tax upon all taxable property in the City sufficient to pay the interest on the bonds, and to provide a sinking fund for the payment of bonds as they mature, for the purpose of making permanent public improvements as follows: (1) purchasing, acquiring, constructing, repairing and improving land, facilities and equipment for public facilities, including acquiring land and easements for such purposes, (2) purchasing equipment and support facilities in connection with such facilities, (3) preparing engineering and related studies in connection with such public facilities within the City and (4) all matters necessary or incidental thereto?

Shall the City Council of the City of Missouri City be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the amount of \$23,015,000 maturing serially or otherwise at such times as may be fixed by the City Council not to exceed 40 years from their date or dates and bearing interest at any rate or rates, either fixed, variable or floating, according to any clearly stated formula, calculation or method not exceeding the maximum interest now or hereafter authorized by law as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council at the time of issuance, and to levy a tax upon all taxable property in the City sufficient to pay the interest on the bonds, and to provide a sinking fund for the payment of bonds as they mature, for the purpose of making permanent public improvements as follows: (1) purchasing, acquiring, constructing, repairing and improving land, facilities, and equipment for parks, including acquiring land and easements for such purposes, (2) purchasing equipment and support facilities in connection with such parks, (3) preparing engineering and related studies in connection with such parks within the City and (4) all matters necessary or incidental thereto?
