
4. RECONVENE into Special Session and Consider Action, if any, on items discussed in Executive Session.

SYNOPSIS

To determine if Code Enforcement should continue to cite certain violations directly to court. Discussion on Court processes and how it relates to Code Enforcement issues.

BACKGROUND

Currently, Code Enforcement is citing five offenses directly to court. This includes junked vehicles, parking on grass, dirty swimming pools, pool fences and high grass and weeds. Other common violations are given warnings which allow anywhere from 10 to 60 days to repair. It is the wish of the Police Department/Code Enforcement that Council would determine if this is a practice they want to continue.
